Since 1982, more than 5,000 international students have studied at the Spanish Institute. Students of all ages, teachers, interns, and volunteers have participated in the Institute's study abroad and language programs, which enable students to improve their Spanish as they learn to communicate easily and effectively while also providing a unique, and enriching opportunity to live in a culturally immersive, majestic city. Centered in Seville, Spain, students have the ability to study in Spanish and English at University of Seville, Pablo De Olavide University, and EUSA University Center.

Study Abroad with Top Spanish Universities

Students combine courses offered at the Spanish Institute with semester or full academic year courses offered at the University of Seville, Pablo de Olavide University, or EUSA University Centre. The Spanish Institute's website highlights course tracks to guide students. Students will benefit from university study, living with Spanish families, exploring Seville and the region, and enhancing their Spanish language skills.



Gain Global Experience with Internships and Volunteering

Students may engage in valuable experiential learning opportunities and practice Spanish through internships and volunteer programming with local companies and nonprofits. Such opportunities allow students to enhance their resumes, build connections, and immerse themselves in Seville's vibrant culture.



Boost Proficiency with Immersive Summer Programs

Students can rapidly improve their Spanish language skills through the Spanish Institute's immersive summer programs. They will engage in intensive, interactive classes and cultural activities designed to help them think and communicate effectively in Spanish.

Deliver Customized Faculty-Directed Courses

Visiting faculty can conduct their university courses at the Spanish Institute, which is equipped with modern facilities including Wi-Fi, projectors, and a library. The Institute organizes accommodation, excursions, and transportation, allowing professors to focus on teaching and exploring Seville. Visiting faculty can choose to stay with a host family or in an apartment, and they can participate in seminars on contemporary topics, such as the evolving role of women in Spain

The Spanish Institute can also organize courses with on-location instructors in a variety of fields designed to meet U.S. curricular needs.



Advance Teaching Skills with Intensive Programs

Teachers participate in the Spanish Institute's one-week programs to refine their teaching strategies, gather new materials, and develop new course modules. These programs offer opportunities to network with educators from around the world and further elevate their teaching skills.



PROGRAM OFFERINGS

The Spanish Institute offers both open enrollment and custom program options.

Students can take advantage of state-of-the art instructional facilities, convenient central city location, access to local universities for semester options, as well as homestays, residences, or shared apartments

Open Enrollment Programs

Spanish Institute offers different types of open-enrollment programs, all of which feature a structured curriculum, organization visits (if applicable), interactive speaker sessions, cultural immersions, and robust student support services.



90 Day (No Visa Required) Study Abroad

For students seeking a full semester of credits without the need for a student visa, the Spanish Institute offers a <u>90-day program</u>. Participants can enroll in up to four courses at the University of Seville, along with the Spanish Institute's Spain Today course. This program spans the full duration of the University of Seville's semester. Students will receive an official transcript from the University of Seville and a transcript for the Spain Today course by the Spanish Institute's School of Record. The 90-day program includes academic excursions and all other services available to all students.



GAP Year

A gap year is a period of one semester or one year after finishing high school and before entering college or a sabbatical university year. This is a time when a new door opens for students and the next stage of their life begins, where they'll want to take their time and live experiences that help them mature and discover the path they wish to follow. The Spanish Institute offers students the opportunity to choose between taking courses at a university in Seville or completing an internship or service-learning position.



Semester Abroad

The Spanish Institute offers students an array of high-quality Spanish language and areastudies courses each semester, as well as internships and service-learning options. Integral to this program is the opportunity for students to study at a Spanish university for a semester or full academic year. Student can select courses from three local universities: the University of Seville, Pablo de Olavide University, or EUSA University Centre. These programs provide a deep immersion into Sevillan life, allowing students to gain a deep understanding of Spanish culture and build global connections.



Summer Academic Programs

During the summer months, students can take Spanish language courses at the Spanish Institute, participate in an internship, service-learning, or apprenticeship opportunity, or combine courses with one of the applied experiences. These options are complemented by instructional excursions and organized cultural engagement.



Custom Programs

Creating a customized education abroad program requires advanced knowledge and planning. The Spanish Institute provides comprehensive support throughout the process, from creating desired syllabi to hiring instructors and managing activities and logistics. Leveraging its extensive networks and streamlined processes, the Spanish Institute guarantees impactful and secure custom programs tailored to meet specific academic and institutional requirements of its partner institutions.



Faculty-Directed Programs

Faculty-directed programs offer university students the perfect opportunity to take short-term, credit-bearing courses in Seville taught by home institution faculty. The Spanish Institute integrates cultural immersion with intellectual exploration in specific academic disciplines.



Professional Development Programs

The Spanish Institute offers didactic training courses for ELE teachers and innovative teaching strategies for Spanish Language Educators. At the Spanish Institute, dynamic pedagogy is their passion, and they have offered teachers Spanish as a Foreign Language for more than 20 years.



Service-Learning Programs

Via its custom service-learning programs, the Institute engages students in projects aligned with community-identified needs. These programs feature interactive workshops, design-thinking activities, hands-on fieldwork, and reflective sessions. They are designed to be credit-bearing with an integrated academic experiential learning course. Placements include opportunities in Spanish, English, or even minimal Spanish. The Spanish Institute offers two-week intensive Spanish language for students needing language preparation.



International Internships

The Institute's offers custom internship programs that provide students with real-world applications of classroom knowledge, enhancing career readiness and employability. The Institute carefully selects and manages placements with organizations to ensure that each student gains invaluable experience in their specific field of study. Students also have the opportunity to utilize Spanish, make new contacts and friends, and get to know Seville from a professional perspective.




INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES IN SEVILLE

Universidad de Sevilla

Closely linked to the history of Seville and Andalusia, the University of Seville combines the values of tradition with being an innovative institution of quality and excellence. It is a university as cutting edge and cosmopolitan as the city of Seville itself and boasts a history of more than 500 years. The courses for international students are part of the university's comprehensive international program that includes a wide variety of subject areas.



Universidad Pablo de Olavide

The Multidisciplinary Studies Program is designed for students wishing to spend a semester or a year abroad while continuing their undergraduate degree. While it offers advanced courses in Spanish, it also caters to the needs of those with little or no background in Spanish by offering classes taught in English in many subject areas.

EUSA Centro Universitario

EUSA Study Abroad Program options include semester or year studies in any of the regular courses offered in official EUSA degrees. These courses are open to local and international students and may be offered in either English, Spanish or both. Their study abroad courses include over 30 different subject areas in Spanish and English, ranging from Media Studies, Business and Human Resources to Cultural Studies, Languages or History.

MACARENA'S REFLECTIONS

I had the pleasure of meeting Kavi Othman Ali in the fall of 2021, when she arrived at the Spanish Institute. Kavi, a young woman from Iraqi Kurdistan, was our first student from Pitzer College after the pandemic, and her life story paired with her determination deeply moved us.

Kavi arrived with a very low level of Spanish, but an enormous will to learn. She trusted our advice and enrolled in courses taught in Spanish at the University of Seville, which was a significant challenge for her. The constant guidance and support from María José, our academic director, were crucial for Kavi to progress in her studies. María José not only advised her on academic matters but also mentored her throughout the program, providing support to overcome all challenges.

Another key pillar of learning in Kavi's experience was her host family. The warmth and affection with which they welcomed Kavi provided her with a home away from home, helping her to adapt to life in Spain. Additionally, her participation in a service-learning program at the NGO La Casa de Todos was an enlightening experience. There, Kavi worked with immigrant families, which not only allowed her to improve her Spanish but also to connect with realities that resonated deeply with her.

Throughout the semester, I had the opportunity to accompany Kavi in her process of adaptation and learning, and together we visited iconic places in Andalusia, such as Granada and Carmona. It was during these trips that our friendship was solidified; Kavi shared with me her life in Iraq, her struggle to study in the United States, and her beautiful dreams for the future.

One of the most heartwarming experiences we shared was when Kavi talked on the phone with her family, especially with her grandmother, to tell her how her life in Spain was going. On one occasion, I had the privilege of participating in one of those calls, and I was deeply moved. Kavi left Seville with tears in her eyes, saying that her experience here had given her the strength she needed to continue pursuing her life's goals.

Since then, we have kept in touch, and Kavi remains a source of inspiration for all of us at the Spanish Institute. Her story is not only a testament to her perseverance but also to the transformative power of the connections forged along the way.

As the leader of the Spanish Institute, my hope is that all students have as rewarding and enriching experience as Kavi.
